Wolf his heirs and assigns forever all the South East quarter of the North West quarter of Section No thirty one Township No Four of Range No Seventeen containing seventy acres more or less being and lying in Lawrence County and State; - this together with all and singular the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions Remainder and remainders Rents issues and profits there of and it's the right title interest claim or demands whatsoever; and the said John Norris and Ellenam Norris either in Law or Equity of and to the said premises with the said hereditaments and appurtenances Do have and to hold the said premises above mentioned and described to the said George W. Wolf his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Norris and Ellenam Norris his wife doth for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators do covenant and agree Grant to and with the said George W. Wolf his heirs and assigns that they John Norris and Ellenam Norris are Lawfully seized infeoff the aforesaid Granted premises that they are free from all incumbrances that they have good Right to sell and convey the same ^{to} the said George W. Wolf as aforesaid and that they will and their heirs Executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to him the said George W. 

Viz, the North East quarter of the South-west quarter of Section thirty three in Township three of Range sixteen in the District of lands subject to sale at Chillicothe Ohio containing forty one acres and ninety Eight hundredth of an acre To have and to hold the premises aforesaid with all the priviledges and appertinances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him the said James G. Thornton and unto his heirs and assigns for Ever and the said Squire Dillion and Sealey his wife for themselves and for their heirs Executors and Administrators covenant and promise to and with the said James G. Thornton his heirs and assigns that they the said Squire Dillion and Sealey his wife are lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid that they have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same in manner aforesaid and that the premises are free and clear of and from all incumbrance whatever and further that they the said Squire Dillion Sealey his wife will well and truly warrant and forever defend the premises herein and hereby granted unto the said James G. 
