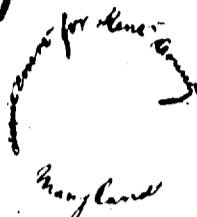

Queen Anne's County to wit: Be it remembered that on this the 24th day of July in the year eighteen hundred and sixty six, the following deed was brought to be recorded to wit:

This deed made this twenty sixth day of May in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and sixty six by us Thos. H. Kemp and Mary Kemp his wife, Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of five hundred and ninety three dollars, seven cents, we the said Thos. H. Kemp and Mary Kemp, his wife do grant unto Noah W. Blunt all that lot of Land near Winchester Creek, being such that is contained within the following metes & bounds, courses & distances, to wit: Beginning at a stone at the North west corner of said lot and running thence North seventy seven degrees thirty minutes East sixty eight perches, thence South thirty one degrees thirty minutes East thirty five perches, thence South thirty four degrees, West twelve perches and a half perch, thence South seventy six degrees, West seventy one perches and one twentieth of a perch to the centre of a creek thence with the cove to the beginning containing seventy three acres, two rods, and thirty nine and a half perches of land.
