

Original Examined of del. W. W. Bryan 1 Dec. 15 1870

Said, bounded and latted as follows to wit: Beginning at a certain stake, corner of land of James R. Eaton and Henrietta B. Ford and running thence with the boundary line between lands of the said James R. Eaton and Henrietta B. Ford South 76° West one hundred and forty three feet (143) to a stake corner of lands of Peter Norrey and Henrietta B. Ford, thence North 1° East one hundred and seventy one foot to a stone planted in the middle of the Road, thence South 46° East one hundred and eighty nine (189) feet to the place of beginning. Containing and laid out for Fifty two and 4/100 acres or less. Together with all and singular the houses, woods, water ways, privileges and appurtenances belonging or in anywise pertaining. To Have and to Hold all and singular the above mentioned and described lot or piece of land, situated lying and being as aforesaid, together with all and singular the houses, woods, waters, ways, and privileges thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto him the said Noah W. Blunt and Martha Blunt his wife and their successors or heirs forever.
